Askwith was part of a project with Robin Alexander in 2003 on Dialogic Teaching. Askwith was judged by Ofsted to be Outstanding in 2009 and was designated as a cohort 1 teaching school in 2011. Askwith is a National Support School and through YCAT is involved with sponsoring schools. Askwith gained accreditation to lead the HART of Yorkshire SCITT in September 2014.
Particular area(s) of Expertise/Strength (please show any supporting data/information	Elaine is the Associate Headteacher at Askwith Primary School part of YCAT, and year 6 teacher.
